- The Awards Committee in evaluating the candidate's materials will use the information provided. Please be descriptive and precise. If additional material is submitted, limit to no more than three pages.
- Each category will receive equal consideration by the selection committee. All categories must be completed.
- The Awards Committee will consider all nominations during their August meeting. Please complete one form per nominee. Reproduce as many forms as needed. The deadline for receipt of nomination is July 16, 2010.
- The recipient will be honored at the ISBA/IAPSS Fall Conference First General Session on Monday, September 27<sup>th</sup> at the Indiana Convention Center.
- Materials submitted for this award are kept on file for two years. If a candidate was nominated for the 2008 or 2009 award, a 2010 Nomination Form must be completed with updated information to be eligible for this year's award.
