

REQUIRED PUBLICATIONS FOR SCHOOL WEBSITES

Updated July 2026

This is a list of required items that Indiana schools must publish on their websites. Please note that this list is not exhaustive. Items 1 through 15 are universally required for all schools, whereas items 16 through 29 are required only under specific circumstances.

1. Cyberbullying Resources (IC 20-19-3-11.5)

- School corporations must maintain a link on their websites that directs patrons to the IDOE resources or best practices regarding the prevention and reporting of bullying and cyberbullying.

2. Posting Information on School Website Home Page (IC 20-19-11-3)

- Each elementary and high school must post the information provided by the IDOE under IC 20-19-11-2 on their school website by October 15 each year. IDOE will supply the following data each year:

For Elementary Schools:

- The pass rate for the reading skills evaluation, ILEARN English/language arts assessment, and ILEARN math assessment.
- The student chronic absenteeism rate.
- The per student funding for the elementary school or school corporation.

For High Schools:

- The average composite SAT score for students.
- The graduation rate, including a separate rate excluding students with a graduation waiver.
- The percentage of students who enrolled in and passed an advanced placement exam, international baccalaureate exam, dual credit course, or Cambridge International exam.
- The per student funding for the high school or school corporation.

3. Employment Contract of the Superintendent (IC 20-26-5-4.3)

- School corporations must post the employment contract of the superintendent.

4. Employment Contracts of Administrators (IC 20-26-5-4.7)

- School corporations must post employment contracts of licensed employees who are not part of the collective bargaining agreement, i.e. administrators.

5. Internet Use Policy (IC 20-26-5-40.5)

- School corporations must post the Internet use policy.

6. Wireless Communication Device Policy (IC 20-26-5-40.7)

- School corporations must post the wireless communication device policy.

7. Reading and Writing Curricula Report (IC 20-26-5-44.2)

- By July 15 each year, every school corporation must post the following: the name and publisher of the adopted reading and writing curricula by grade level, information on remedial programs provided, including the applicable grade levels, and contact information for a designated administrator who can provide further details on the curricula and remedial programs.

8. Catalogue of Library Materials and Library Book Policy (IC 20-26-5.5-2)

- Schools must post the catalog of materials available in their school libraries and the policy adopted by the school board allowing a patron to request removal of a library book.

9. Student Transfer Requests (IC 20-26-11-32)

- School corporations must post the date by which requests to transfer into the school corporation must be received.

10. Posting Annual Performance Evaluation Plan (IC 20-28-11.5-4)

- School corporations must post the evaluation plan developed or adopted by the school corporation on the school corporation's website.

11. Collective Bargaining Provisions (IC 20-29-6-19)

- School corporations must post notice of the public meeting wherein the tentative collective bargaining agreement will be discussed. This notice must be posted at least 72 hours before the meeting. School corporations must post the tentative collective bargaining agreement with this notice.
- School corporations must post the final collective bargaining agreement. The agreement must be posted within 14 business days after an agreement is reached.

12. School Corporation Posting of Online Course Information (IC 20-30-16-9.5)

- If a school corporation is an authorized provider of approved online course access programs, it must post the name and description of available online courses, as well as the number of open slots per course.

13. Track School Performance in Program Areas (IC 20-31-8-5.5)

- Schools must post a link to their school performance data GPS dashboard conspicuously.

14. Dyslexia Intervention Report (IC 20-35.5-5-2)

- School corporations must annually report by July 15 the dyslexia intervention programs used in the previous school year, the number of students who received these interventions, and the total number of students identified with dyslexia.

15. Posting of Information Regarding Local Liaisons & McKinney-Vento Act (IC 20-50-1-5)

- School corporations must post the contact information of the liaison for homeless children and certain information related to the McKinney-Vento Act.

16. Development and Implementation of Child Abuse and Child Sexual Abuse Education Program (IC 20-19-3-11)

- If schools choose to use the model educational materials on child abuse and child sexual abuse provided by the IDOE, they must notify parents in writing and through the school's website that they can examine and review the materials beforehand and have the option to decide whether their child will receive instruction using these materials.

17. Notice Requirements (IC 20-23-5-9)

- If two school corporations agree to territory annexation changes, they must publish notices about the proposed changes in local newspapers and on their websites. The notice must be published twice, one week apart, with the first notice in the newspapers and the second notice following IC 5-3-5 guidelines and appearing on the websites of both the acquiring and losing school corporations.

18. Annexation Notice (IC 20-25-5-13)

- If two school corporations agree to territory annexation changes, they must post notice of the proposed annexation on their websites.

19. Superintendent Contract (IC 20-26-5-4.3)

- School boards must post notice of the meeting wherein the school board will hear public comment on a proposed contract with the superintendent and the details of the proposed contract with the superintendent before entering into a new contract.

20. Notice for Failure to Meet Minimum Teacher Salary Threshold (IC 20-28-9-26)

- If a school corporation receives a notice from the IDOE regarding failure to meet the minimum teacher salary threshold, the school corporation must publish the department's notice and any relevant individual reports.

21. School Corporation Expenditure for Teacher Salaries (IC 20-28-9-27)

- If a school corporation receives a notice from the IDOE regarding failure to meet teacher salary expenditure requirements, the school corporation must publish the department's notice and any relevant individual reports.

22. Human Sexuality Instruction Materials (IC 20-30-5-17)

- A school corporation must publish a list of any instructional materials, including teachers' manuals, curricular materials, films or other video materials, tapes, and other materials, used in connection with instruction on human sexuality on the school's website.

23. Excessive Education Fund Transfer List Notice (IC 20-40-2-9)

- If a school corporation receives notice from the IDOE regarding excessive education fund transfers, the school corporation must post the department's notice and any relevant individual reports within 30 days after the public meeting wherein the notice was acknowledged.

24. Explanatory Documentation and Official Recommendation (IC 20-40-2-10)

- A school corporation that has received notice from the IDOE regarding excessive fund transfer must post explanatory documentation and any further notices and related reports from the IDOE.
- A school corporation that remains on the excessive fund transfer list for at least two years must also post recommendations by the DUAB.

25. Capital Projects Plan (IC 20-40-18-6)

- School corporations who want to use the Operations Fund for expenditures related to capital asset acquisition or for projects that are capital in nature must develop and hold a public hearing on a three-year Capital Projects Plan. The plan must be posted on the corporation's website prior to the public hearing.

26. School Bus Replacement Plan (IC 20-40-18-9)

- School corporations that want to use the Operations Fund to pay for the replacement of school buses must develop a bus replacement plan and hold a public hearing on the plan that estimates the future cost of bus replacement expenditures for, at a minimum, the next five years. The plan must be posted on the school corporation website prior to the public hearing.

27. Resolution for Operating Referendum Tax Levy (IC 20-46-1-8)

- School corporations in certain counties that must share referendum dollars with charter schools must post a referendum disclosure statement at least 30 days before the referendum is voted on in a primary or general election.

28. Resolution for School Safety Referendum Levy (IC 20-46-9-6)

- School corporations in certain counties that must share referendum dollars with charter schools must post a referendum disclosure statement at least 30 days before the referendum is voted on in a primary or general election.
