MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

The Indiana School Boards Association (ISBA) approved the creation of the Indiana Council of School Attorneys (ICOSA) and its affiliation with the National School Boards Association’s Council of School Attorneys (COSA) in 2016. Attorneys who represent on a regular or continuing basis a school corporation or educational entity that is a member of the ISBA and who are licensed to practice and are in good standing with the Bar of Indiana are eligible to join ICOSA. Because of the affiliation with COSA, membership in both Councils is required.

Attorneys who represent on a regular or continuing basis a school corporation or educational entity that is a member of the ISBA and who are licensed to practice and are in good standing with the Bar of Indiana are eligible to apply for membership in ICOSA. To qualify for membership, an attorney must complete this application and submit the approved dues of both COSA and ICOSA. The membership period for both organizations will be July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019.
